The state requires camp directors to keep signed hard copies of the Health History and Adult Information forms for each adult in camp, as well as a Health History for each youth in camp.

1. Youth Protection Training Card

Attach a photocopy of your "Youth Protection Training" card from BSA's Online YPT course.
HOW TO get a YPT card:
Go to www.SHAC.org. Go to *Training*. Click on *Youth Protection*
Click on "*MyScouting*" portal Register in the *BSA Online Learning Center*.
In the box for "Council" at the bottom of the registration page select: "*Sam Houston Area Council-576*".
In the box for "Person ID" at the bottom of the page enter your BSA Person ID number from your BSA Registration card. If you don't have a BSA Person ID number just leave it blank. It is not required. (You can also enter it at a later date.)
Take the Online YPT Course and test.
PRINT the screen that shows your card after you take the test (in case you don't get the email with your card)
Write down the date you take the course. (It can help you get a card later in case there is printer or computer error after you finish)
NOTE: the State of Texas has approved ONLY the BSA Online YPT course for adults attending camp.
